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The City of Orange Township Developing New 10-Year Master Plan

ORANGE TOWNSHIP, NJ - The City of Orange Township will create a new Master Plan for the City, which will provide a blue print for the City's growth and development over the next 10 years. The Master Plan creates a comprehensive vision for the City, in the areas of land use, housing, economic development, transportation and sustainability.

THE GOAL OF THE MASTER PLAN

The plan allows for a well thought out approach to planning and addressing planning related issues, all aimed at improving the quality of life for residents and creating a more favorable business environment for those doing business in the City.

The master planning process provides an opportunity for residents and other stakeholders to articulate a vision for the City.

PLAN DEVELOPMENT

The Nishuane Group will facilitate the development of the Plan. Planners from The Nishuane Group will work closely with a steering committee comprised of municipal department heads, residents, and a cross section of other stakeholders, including representatives from the business, non-profit, religious and education sectors, to advance the development of the Plan.

Over the next three months, several focus groups and community meetings will be held for residents and other stakeholders to provide their input.

Mayor Dwayne D. Warren said, "This is a rare, once-in-a-generation opportunity where citizens can shape the future of Orange by participating in community meetings. We owe it our children to get involved and let our voices be heard which will impact the quality of life in Orange for years to come."
