# Dieter Lerch - Budget Consultant

- Provided an overview and responded to specific questions from Council Members for CY 2013 Budget ending on December 31, 2013.
  - Councilwoman Eason expressed concern with the lack of cuts that was not implemented and would like to know if the City has enough funds in the budget to operate; Highlighted Resolution 366-2013 Transfer Appropriation are directly into Salaries; Presented questions concerns consequences and/or sanctions onto the Administration for lack of Budget Compliance. Made inquiry into Resolution 365-2013 is there enough monies.
  - o <u>Councilman Corbitt</u> inquired as to whether there are enough monies for salaries in the budget; Can Lerch determine percentage of fund usage and if there are enough monies in the budget to operate; Expressed the need to impose sanctions onto the Administration.
  - o <u>Councilwoman Jones-Bell</u> made inquiry into co-mingling of monies on line items.
  - o <u>Council President Williams</u> encourage Council Members to present questions to Lerch to present to the Administration. Made inquiry into the absence of the Director of Finance and CFO; explored the possibility of excess salary funds that can be transferred to other line items.
