

BID NOTICE
CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, ESSEX COUNTY, NJ
FY 2012 NJDOT MUNICIPAL AID
MONROE STREET AND CONOVER TERRACE RESURFACING

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the City of Orange Township, Essex County, New Jersey for the **FY 2012 NJDOT LOCAL AID PROJECT – MONROE STREET AND CONOVER TERRACE RESURFACING** and shall be opened and read in public at City Hall in the Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, 29 North Day Street, Orange, NJ 07050 on **Friday, November 1, 2013 at 10:00 AM** prevailing time.

Bid Documents may be examined and obtained during the hours of 9:00 am to 4:00 pm , Monday through Friday, except Holidays, at the Public Works Office, Third Floor, City Hall, 29 North Day Street, Orange, NJ. **Bid Documents may not be examined on the day of the receipt of bids.**

Prospective Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Bid Documents by request upon proper notice and payment of a non-refundable fee of **\$ 75.00, made payable to Carroll Engineering**, to defray the cost thereof. If a prospective bidder requests that bid documents be mailed, costs for postage or overnight delivery shall be borne by the bidder, and shall be pre-paid.

The work to be performed under the contract includes the following: Milling and paving, site clearing, roadway repair, removal and replacement of concrete curb, driveway apron and sidewalk replacement, minor drainage improvements, adjusting storm & sanitary castings to grade, and striping. The following list of roads is intended to be improved as part of this project:

- Monroe Street (Jefferson Street to Bell Street)
- Conover Terrace (Scotland Road to Lincoln Avenue)

Unless otherwise specifically noted, all work is to be in compliance with the New Jersey Department of Transportation, Standard Specifications for Road and Bridge Construction 2007 U.S. Customary English Units, as amended. The project is funded by a Municipal Aid grant from the New Jersey Department of Transportation, and all regulations pertaining to the grant are incorporated into the project.

All work is to be inspected, by a representative of the Engineer. Quantity tickets will be collected by a representative of the Engineer, at the time of delivery of the specific load only. No tickets will be accepted, for any quantities of materials at any other time. Items will be measured within the prescribed pay limits indicated on the Contract Drawings.

The Owner reserves the right execute a Contract with the successful low bidder, but to delay the issuance of the Notice to Proceed until the Spring of 2014, as determined or influenced by weather or other considerations, at the sole discretion of the Owner. Following the issuance of the Notice to Proceed, the Contractor shall have ninety (90) calendar days to substantially complete the Work.

All bids shall be **addressed to the Public Works Department, City of Orange Township, at the address indicated above.** Bids, along with bid securities, and all other required bid documents, must be enclosed in a properly SEALED envelope, bearing on the outside of the envelope the name and address of the bidder and the **NATURE OF THE BID CONTAINED THEREIN.** All bids will be publicly opened and read at the Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, City Hall, 29 North Day Street,

Orange, NJ 07050, on the date and time mentioned above. Bidders using overnight delivery services are cautioned that the Bidder is responsible to ensure that the bids are delivered to the Office of the Department Public Works, Third Floor, City Hall, on or before the date and time of the bid opening. Bids delivered to the Mail Room or elsewhere in City Hall, and which do not arrive at the Office of the Department of Public Works on or before the date and time of bid opening, will be considered late, and, as such, will not be opened.

A Bid Security is required in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid, but not more than \$20,000, in the form of a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check, made payable to the City of Orange Township.

Bidders, when appropriate, shall comply with the provisions of the following laws of New Jersey: P.L. 1963 c. 150 (Prevailing Wage Act); P.L. 1977 c.33 (Corporation and/or Partnership Owner Information); and any subsequent amendments thereto. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 (Affirmative Action) and P.L. 2004, c. 57 (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) (Business Registration), and P.L. 1999, C. 238, Public Works Contractor Registration Act.

The City of Orange reserves the right to award or reject any or all bids, waive any minor defects, and in the case of a tie, award on the basis of reasonable grounds, or accept the bid that in its judgment will be for the best interests of the City, and consider bids for sixty (60) days after their receipt.
