

RE-BID NOTICE
CITY OF ORANGE TOWNSHIP, ESSEX COUNTY, NJ
MONROE STREET SANITARY SEWER LINING

Notice is hereby given that sealed proposals will be received by the City of Orange Township, Essex County, New Jersey for the **MONROE STREET SANITARY SEWER LINING** and shall be opened and read in public at City Hall Council Chambers, 4th Floor, 29 North Day Street, Orange, NJ 07050 on **Thursday, May 8, 2014 at 11:00 a.m.**, prevailing time.

Bid Documents may be examined and furnished during the hours of 9:00 am to 4:00 pm , Monday through Friday, except Holidays, at the Public Works Office, Third Floor, City Hall, 29 North Day Street, Orange, NJ. Prospective Bidders will be furnished with a copy of the Bid Documents by request upon proper notice and payment of a non-refundable fee of **\$25.00, made payable to Carroll Engineering**, to defray the cost thereof. If a prospective bidder requests that bid documents be mailed, costs for postage or overnight delivery shall be borne by the bidder and shall be pre-paid. **Bid Documents may not be examined on the day of the receipt of bids.**

The work to be performed under the contract includes the following: Cleaning of approximately 540 linear feet of existing 15-inch and 18-inch diameter vitrified tile pipe sanitary sewer, CCTV inspection of the sanitary sewer and the installation of cured in place pipe (CIPP) lining. Bypass pumping during the CCTV inspection and the installation of the CIPP lining is included in this contract. The limit of the CIPP lining is Monroe Street between Jefferson Street and Bell Street.

All work is to be inspected by a representative of the Engineer. Following the issuance of the Notice to Proceed, the Contractor shall have twenty (20) calendar days to complete the Work.

All bids shall be **addressed to the Public Works Department, City of Orange Township, at the address indicated above.** Bids, together with bid securities and all other required bid documents, must be enclosed in a properly **SEALED** envelope, bearing on the outside of the envelope the name and address of the bidder and the **NATURE OF THE BID CONTAINED THEREIN.** All bids will be publicly opened and read in the Council Chambers, Fourth Floor, City Hall, 29 North Day Street, Orange, NJ 07050, on the date and time stated above. Bidders using overnight delivery services are cautioned that the Bidder is responsible to ensure that the bids are delivered to the Public Works Office, Third Floor, City Hall, on or before the date and time of the bid opening. Bids delivered to the Mail Room or elsewhere in City Hall, and which do not arrive at the Public Works Office on or before the date and time of bid opening, will be considered late, and, as such, will not be opened.

A Bid Security is required in the amount of ten percent (10%) of the total bid, but not more than \$20,000, in the form of a bid bond, certified check or cashier's check, made payable to the City of Orange Township.

Bidders, when appropriate, shall comply with the provisions of the following laws of New Jersey: P.L. 1963 c. 150 (Prevailing Wage Act); P.L. 1977 c.33 (Corporation and/or Partnership Owner Information); and any subsequent amendments thereto. Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of N.J.S.A. 10:5-31 et seq. and N.J.A.C. 17:27 (Affirmative Action) and P.L. 2004, c. 57 (N.J.S.A. 52:32-44) (Business Registration), and P.L. 1999, C. 238, Public Works Contractor Registration Act.

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The City of Orange reserves the right to award or reject any or all bids, waive any minor defects, and in the case of a tie, award on the basis of reasonable grounds, or accept the bid that in its judgment will be for the best interests of the City, and consider bids for sixty (60) days after their receipt.
