Licensed Insurance Broker For the Placement of Property and Casualty Insurance

The City of Orange Township, County of Essex, State of New Jersey, is soliciting proposals for a Licensed Insurance Broker for the placement of **1) general liability, 2) workers compensation and employer's liability, 3) auto liability, 4) inland marine liability, 5) medical professional liability, and 6) property liability & Boiler Machinery/Systems Breakdown insurance** for March 2014 to March 2016.

QUALIFICATIONS:

- The firm must be licensed to conduct business in the State of New Jersey, and have at least five (5) years experience in providing services referenced herein.
- Must have experience and knowledge of the rules and regulations of the New Jersey Department of Banking and Insurance and New Jersey Tort Law.

REQUIREMENTS FOR RESPONSE:

- Legal name and address of firm. Firm must have a bona find office in the State of New Jersey.
- Years in business.
- Resumes of staff to be assigned including email addresses.
- The names and contact information of other public entity clients.
- Any associate who may handle the municipality's work must have an identifiable supervisor who will be responsible for direct oversight and assistance to the municipality.
- Dollar quotation matching current policy parameters.

Five (5) copies of Response shall be submitted in a sealed envelope plainly marked to indicate the name and address of the proposer, and the subject of the proposal. **Responses may either be mailed or delivered in person to Adrian O. Responses received after the time for opening proposals will be returned unopened. The City of Orange Township is not responsible for late delivery by the United States Postal Service or any other carrier.

Bidders are required to comply with the requirements of P.L. 1975, c.127 (N.J.A.C. 17:27 et seq.), the Affirmative Action Law and Local Unity Pay to Play Law (P.L. 2004, c19, as amended by P.L. 2005, c51).
