

Senior vaccine clinics begin

City officials announced last week the Nursing Division would conduct its annual flu and pneumonia vaccination clinics for senior residents.

The clinics began Wednesday at Salem Towers. Five more sessions are scheduled:

- Tuesday: Washington Manor, 340 Thomas Blvd., 10 a.m. to 1 p.m.
- Sept. 29: Orange City Hall, 29 N. Day St., 1 to 4 p.m.
- Oct. 6: Oakwood Towers, 400 Oakwood Ave., 9 a.m. to 1 p.m.

- Oct. 14: New Community Senior Citizens Center, 132 William St., 1 to 4 p.m.

- Oct. 28: Orange City Hall, 29 N. Day St., 8:30 a.m. to noon.

Residents must be at least 65 years of age to be eligible. Those on Medicare are urged to bring their traditional Medicare card. Individuals with Medicare Advantage plans will have co-payments. No Medicaid plans will be accepted.
