

## Orange receives train station grant

The Lincoln Avenue train station and adjacent Tony Galento Plaza may receive some improvements after the city received a \$583,000 grant from the state's Transportation Trust Fund, city officials announced Tuesday.

City officials said the grant will be used to landscape Tony Galento Plaza and improve the pedestrian corridor from the train station to Main Street. It will include resurfacing the parking lot, replacing brick pavers, planting trees, installing benches and providing other streetscape improvements. In May, Gov. Jon S. Corzine designated Orange as the state's 20th Transit Village. The city was awarded \$100,000 in state funds as part of its designation.
