Both are using the QOF and are seeking investors. The only exception is that Reock I is no longer seeking investors, as that project is already fully funded. I spoke to Joe Brisk. Although 448 Scotland Road is located in census tract 189, an Orange Opportunity Zone, Joe stated that the project will not be using the QOF. I reached out for Chris Minks on Friday by phone and sent an email, but didn't receive a

response. I included Russo's projects on the list and indicated "unknown" regarding whether they are seeking investors. Finally, the Berwyn Street project is not located in an opportunity zone and is not listed. Please let me know if you have any questions or require additional information.
